Wheat Beer (4.4%)

Unlike Bavarian or Belgian wheat beers, which are lightly hopped, MacLir comes armed with a veritable oast house full of little green plants. Pride of Ringwood from New Zealand, Cascade and Cluster from the US, Saaz from the Czech Republic, Styrian Goldings from Slovenia, and First Gold and Goldings from England.

The beer is superb, with resin hops and lemon fruit on the aroma, banana and lemon in the mouth, and a big, bitter finish dominated by the hops, juicy malt and citrus fruit.
